Pastor Alex Speaks

"What would it take for you to stop believing in Jesus and give up on the Christian faith?" This was the question that was addressed to my Christian Philosophy professor Joseph Okello by an atheist in a past debate. Dr. Okello, thought for a moment, looked at the atheist and replied, "produce for me the dead body of Jesus." What is Okello implying? Basically, If the resurrection of Jesus didn't happen then the whole Christian faith would topple like a house of cards. There would be no point to the gospel, the church, and the New Testament. In other words, game over.

It is not just Okello's words, it is also the words of the Apostle Paul. He writes, "... if Christ has not been raised, all of our preaching has been for nothing and your faith is useless" **1 Corinthians 15:14**. Fortunately, we do have great historical evidences that Jesus did rise from the dead, one particular evidence is Jesus' appeared to eyewitnesses. People actually saw Jesus, alive! There was not just one or two or even a small group, there were hundreds who saw him; more than 500 (**1 Corinthians 15:6**). Even skeptics like Jesus' brother James, Thomas, and Paul put aside their intellectual skepticism and scoffing after they physically saw Jesus alive from the dead.

At this present time, there is more shelf space than there is food. Yet, with compassionate hearts from our congregation we come together and stock the shelves throughout the year. Therefore, those that come seeking can receive.

The goal is to feed the hunger both physically and spiritually. At Grace Church, we are blessed to have Tracy Maher and Karin Gambon. These two women have a passion to feed the hungry. Knowing first-hand the struggles life presents, each has committed to building up the food pantry.

Both Tracy and Karin dedicate time weekly by welcoming in inventory, checking expiration dates and seeking opportunities in the community to help stock the shelves. All this effort is done to fill bags up and bless those that come in need.

This small team within this small church not only feeds with food. Prayer is a big part of the Food Pantry Ministry. Conversation and invitation to services are part of the norm on distribution day. Tracy and Karin serve on Thursdays from 11am to 1pm in the church foyer.

They welcome donations of food or monetary support to purchase items most needed. Items such as peanut butter, jelly, tuna, cereal and pasta are in constant need. No expired items can be accepted as per regulations.

Why do I tell you all of this? Simply because hunger is a major issue in our community. It will not go away anytime soon. The hungry will continue to be on street corners, in store entry ways and yes, they will keep coming to the churches.

No one person can do it, but as a community we can help. Let's come together and feed people with food. That act alone will feed their hearts and show the love of Jesus.

## Tuesday Morning Prayer Meetings at Grace Church in Port St. Lucie, FL

Prayer is the heartbeat of the church and that is consistent with **1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 (KJV)** where we are told to **"Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you."** The WORD is God talking to us; PRAYER is when his children talk to Him.

Devoted and diligent prayer is what takes place every Tuesday at 11:30 a.m. in the Grace Church Theater (Sanctuary) located on US1 in Port St. Lucie where the one-hour (up to one and a half hour) session is open to the public. Judy McHenry (Church Secretary) provides a list of prayer requests from request cards received from the previous Sunday's Services and information passed on from members, attendees and others in desire of prayer for themselves or those with known needs and/or aspirations. A list of the week's prayer requests is distributed to each person in attendance at the prayer meeting and thus becomes the agenda for the day.

Barbara Perry (Guest Services) guides the prayer sessions (which are truly led by the Spirit). There are always at least two intercessors to pray (those that plead a cause or causes on behalf of others to God and that defy the works of darkness that come against God's people in Jesus' name) ---- which makes each session scripturally sound: **"For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them."** **Matthew 18:20 (KJV)**

After about 5-10 minutes previewing the prayer request list together through sharing some insights and/or updates (including praise reports) on some situations ---- we also share some needs and concerns that are on our individual hearts as intercessors and plot out how to incorporate them in our prayers as the Spirit moves all around and sometimes back and forth from one intercessor to another in accomplishing that every request is addressed. This comprises our strategy as we prepare to engage in spiritual warfare on behalf of the members

and attendees of Grace Church, our community, our state, our country and all the nations of the world saved and unsaved.

The prerequisite to praying is in humbling ourselves quietly with eyes closed and heads bowed in submission to God's will and purpose as the Holy Spirit moves on an intercessor to start the prayer session and we then know what to do as it is revealed in **Hebrews 4:16 (NKJV): "Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need."**

The intercessors plead the cause for which the Spirit has led them to pray and signal others of their completion by saying a few words as, "In Jesus name . . . Amen. There is a brief silence as the Spirit moves to prompt the next prayer as each intercessor has a unique style and area of effectiveness (**"Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much."** **James 5:16 KJV**); the intercessors are mindful of each other's gift and are patient as we, **"Wait on the Lord: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the Lord."** **Psalms 27:14 (KJV)**

Sometimes nearing the end of our session, the Spirit cease moving and there is a breakout where and when further clarity or discussion is needed so that we can pray and agree intelligently through enlightenment and not be prone to obstacles and hindrances encountered in darkness (ignorance or inaccuracy). As we proceed in the Spirit to ensure thoroughness with all requests, we wind down with a closing prayer by guide Barbara Perry, or a designee.

As prayer warriors, intercessors are tenacious (extremely persistent in adhering to or doing something relentlessly) in our spirits and apply attention to detail in presenting our case on behalf of those who are standing in the need of prayer.

Truly, we must pray without ceasing and become such fine-tuned instruments of prayer that we pray consciously and without realizing, subconsciously as well. That's why the study of the WORD is crucial to living a victorious life as it is the Sword of the Spirit. **"Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God."** **Ephesians 6:17.** When you speak the WORD with your tongue as a two-edged sword----you can dice up, cut up and cut out all hindrances and obstructions in your way with authority in Jesus' name.

When we pray the Word---speaking it back to Him, this is what He says in **Isaiah 55:11 (KJV): "So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it."**

Pastor Tim Williams (lovingly known and admired by his congregation, and throughout the community, as "Pastor Tim"), refers to those that intercede in prayer at Grace Church as "prayer warriors." **"For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds; Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ."** **2 Corinthians 10:4-5 (KJV).**

It is thought by some that perhaps a second prayer meeting on another day at night would allow those that are working or unavailable during the day to also participate in something we know is so important to our Lord, that souls be saved, broken hearts are mended, and the captives are set free.

This is all for God's Kingdom . . . for as we labor—God gives us power to accomplish all that He has planned for us (through obedience) which in turn makes us pleasing in His sight. There is no greater joy for us than to please the Father who, when we let Him, supplies everything. **"But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus."** **Philippians 4:19**


